### World Book Day - Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March

This year we want to promote the value of reading to children, particularly a bedtime story. If we want the children to use adventurous vocabulary, they need to hear these words in context. We are asking children to come dressed in pyjamas, dressing gowns and onesies and bring with them their favourite bedtime story. In addition, we would like to run a 'book trade' whereby every child brings a book to donate / swap with another child in the class. This way, we can recycle quality stories and every child will come home with a different book. This is not a book sale, every child would only need to bring in one book to swap.

### Medicines in School

### Reporting illness

Please can you let us know the reason your child is unwell when you report an absence. It is important that we record this so that we can look for trends and patterns, particularly in cases of vomiting. If your child is vomiting or has diarrhoea, they should not return to school for 48 hours from when the symptoms ceased. Please support us in this so that we can keep our school community healthy.

**Epipens and inhalers**

If your child needs an epipen or an inhaler we must be informed and we need to have this in school all the time. We have recently been made aware of children who require this medication and the school has not been informed. This puts children at risk.

**Shoes for Ecce Homo charity**

The shoes will be collected at half term so please leave any pairs in the dome next week. Thank you for your support with this, many children need shoes to be able to access school.

**Student Council Network logo competition**

**Headlice**
