## **Covid update**

Following a meeting between contact tracing, Headteachers and CPYES, we have updated our risk assessments and we continue to have mitigations in place. Touchpoint cleaning remains key as the variant is more transmissible this way.

As a reminder, if we have a confirmed positive case at school, the direct contacts (class bubble) will be notified by email and asked to isolate until contact tracing call. This may require pick up from school. The rest of the school will be notified of the case but can attend. The isolation for the direct contacts will be lifted after a Day 10 negative result.

## **Transition Day**

Next Friday, the children will spend the day with their new teacher, in their new class. They can go straight to their new class when they arrive, pick up will be staggered as normal.

## **Rights Respecting Gold Award** (Article 29 & 42)

Last week, we took part in a rigorous assessment day to share our evidence with UNICEF, to become the second Jersey Primary School to receive Gold level status. The day went well and included interviews with children of all ages. We are awaiting confirmation from the UNICEF panel and expect to receive this before the end of term.
