Dictionaries and Thesauruses Article 28- We have the right to an education	We asked Mrs Wiseman to order new dictionaries and thesauruses. We now have new dictionaries and thesauruses for KS2 and some new dictionaries for Year 2. We will talk to everyone about it in assembly in January. Focus boxes Article 28- We have the right to an education	Y1: Have 1x ear-defenders and would like more Y2: Have 4 ear-defenders and six focus boards and would like more ear- defenders, 5 minute timers and wobble cushions. Y3: Have 7 ear-defenders and 7 focus boards. They would like wobble cushions, writing boards, affirmation cards, fidgets and pencil grips. Y4: Have got 1 focus board, 1x ear-defenders. They would like more wobble boards. Y5: Have got 1 x ear-defenders and 5 focus boards (broken) They would like fidgets and wobble cushions Y6: Have got 3 focus boards, 5 ear-defenders, 1 wobble board, 3 wobble cushions (1 broken) We talked about ear defenders and focus boards and think that if we get some, we will need to remind people what they are for. We do find them helpful and would like to have more for each class. We also think that wobble-cushions and wobble-boards might be helpful for some people. Year 3 suggested affirmation cards and we all thought that this was a great idea. Milly said that they would be nice if someone is having a bad day. We will also need to speak to Mrs Charlesworth about our budget, as we may need to raise some money if we want these things.	





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	Other people thought that they can be helpful for some people. One of our School Council members said that they keep an elastic band around their wrist that they fidget with, and they feel that this is helpful for them. They suggested that we find some things that are small and not distracting. We also talked about having these on teacher's desk/drawer rather than the focus box, so that people use them after having a conversation with their teacher first.
