


Home Learning Task – Year 5

Maybe your garden or a park. Measure the length of each side. Calculate the perimeter of the shape. Can you also work out the area?</p> 	<p>Science task</p> <p>Visit the butterfly enclosure at Jersey Zoo. What is the habitat like for the butterflies? Is it similar or different to Jersey’s climate and habitats?</p> 
<p>Topic task</p> <p>Research the history of your chosen Egyptian Pharaoh or God.</p> 	<p>Outdoor activity –physical</p> <p>Have you ever played petanque? If you can, find some petanque balls and play with a friend or a family member down on the beach or in the garden.</p>	<p>Research task</p> <p>Create some top trump cards for Egyptian Pharaohs.</p> 	<p>Literacy in the environment</p> <p>Visit the Wetlands Centre in St Ouen’s Bay and read all about the animals and habitats that are found there.</p> 
<p>Family focused task</p> <p>Interview an adult in your family about what their life was like when they were your age. You could ask about hobbies, subjects learnt at school etc.</p>	<p>Reading task</p> <p>Ask a friend to recommend a book to you. Try reading it and see what you think. You might discover a new author you like or find out more about something you didn’t know about before!</p>	<p>Science Task:</p> <p>Choose an animal and research its life cycle. Draw out the diagram making notes for each stage.</p> 	<p>Task of the child / family’s choosing</p> <p>Take part in an activity of your own choice either alone or with family/friends.</p>
