<p>Art / craft task Create an outdoor piece of Art, using natural materials. It could be in your garden or at the beach. Talk about these places and the similarities and differences with life in Jersey.</p> <p>What is the weather like? What time-zone are these places in? Which continent?</p> 	<p>Outdoor activity –physical Find an open-space and practise some athletic activities. Can you set yourself a target and increase your running speed?</p> 	<p>Research task Research the water cycle. Where does the water come from before it reaches our tap? Can you make a model of the water cycle?</p> 	<p>Literacy Have a go at a Dictionary-Scavenger-Hunt. Get an adult to give you a list of words and see if you can find them in a dictionary. Can you create your own for someone in your family to complete?</p> 
<p>Family focused task Can you pick out some of your favourite books and read them with your family? Think about why they are special to you.</p> <p>Ask some people in your family to share their favourite books with you. Can they tell you why they are special to them?</p> 	<p>Investigation-work Have a think about the Global goals. If you could choose one of the Global goals that you consider to have the greatest priority, what would it be? Can you find out about the progress the world is making towards achieving this goal?</p> 	<p>Reading Write a book review of your favourite book. Bring it to school and share it with a friend.</p> 	<p>Task of your choosing</p> <p>Choose something new to do with your family. It could be a game outdoors that you haven't played before, a new recipe to make or any new activity that you would like.</p>
