What You Need to Do

There are amazing prizes for three age groups:

- Reception to Year 2
- Year 3 to Year 4
- Year 5 to Year 6

Each category will have a 1st prize (£100 value), 2nd prize (£50 value), and 3rd prize (£20 value). Plus, your artwork might be displayed on our website or featured in exciting ways after the event!

How to Enter

1. Create your artwork on an A4 template (you can paint, draw, or use mixed media).
2. **Artwork must be given to the Eco reps in each class by Friday 7th February**
