Primary teacher ends 32-year career

A PRIMARY school teacher who is retiring after 32 years was given an emotional send-off at a special assembly in her honour this week.

Joan Simon worked at Les Landen School for 20 years and before that taught at St Mary and Plat Dooet schools.

And although she said she wouldn't miss the planning and the paperwork, Mrs Simon - now a grandmother - said that she had enjoyed every minute of her job.

'I always wanted to go to work,' she said. 'For me, it has been about helping kids to reach their potential. It has been hard work and I won't miss the paperwork, but I am going to miss everybody - the friendships, the community spirit and the love from

everybody which has kept me here for 20 years.'

Mrs Simon started at Plat Dooet fresh out of teaching training college, moving on to St Mary where she taught for 11 years, and then to Les Landen. She taught Year 1 classes until nine years ago, when she moved up to Year 3, and for the last six years she taught sport.

For a number of years Mrs Simon also job-shared with her daughter, teaching from Monday to Wednesday with her daughter teaching on Thursday and Friday.

But now Mrs Simon, who was guest of honour at the assembly on Thursday, will swap the classroom for the school run to Les Landen, as one of her grandchildren already attends the school and another is due to start in September.

'I am going to stay involved but as a grandmother,' she said. 'I will also be looking after my two other grandchildren for two days a week. My advice to anyone wanting to be a teacher would be to enjoy it. You have to love kids, because if you don't, I don't know how you can teach.'
